

TITLE: Sculptural Tetrahedron Book with Pop-Up

Shared by Mary Kulas

Objective: Students will explore sculptural book-making which will include a pop-up element and collaged photographs.

Supplies:

5 rhombus shapes (construction paper or tag) (equally sized) per student

Glue

collage materials such as photographs (optional)

Drawing media (optional)

1. Students will begin by folding 3 rhombus shapes in half (which will create equilateral triangles).
2. The 3 folded shapes will be opened; then one half of each paper will be layered with the other 2 papers and glued. One half of each rhombus will remain free. The unglued portion of the rhombus can be lifted up to create a tetrahedron. See photograph.
3. Another rhombus can be folded and cut to create a pop-up element that can be glued into the paper tetrahedron. Photographs and/or other materials can be glued in place. Drawing media can also be used on the structure.
