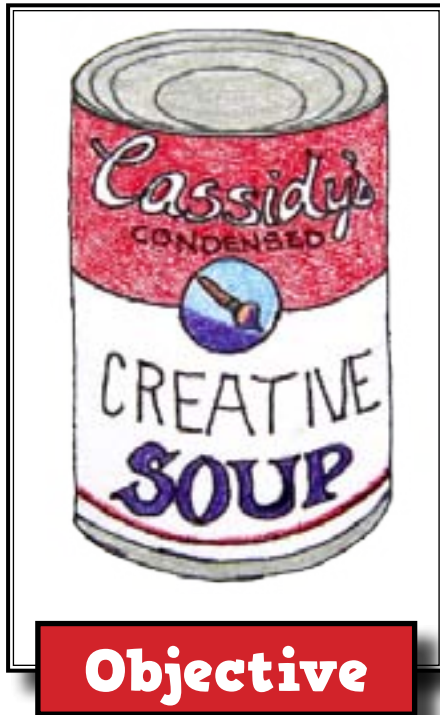


What brand of soup am I?



Objective

Students will create an Andy Warhol inspired personalized soup can.

Materials:

- Pencil
- Eraser
- Colored pencils
- Sharpie markers
- Paper 9x12
- Reproduction of Andy Warhol's [Campbell's Soup Cans](#)

Vocabulary:

- Pop Art - art based on popular culture and mass media influences.
- Andy Warhol - a painter, printmaker and filmmaker who was well known as a Pop artist.

Directions:

1. Draw a soup can on a piece of paper.
2. Start by drawing an oval at the top of the paper. Add smaller ovals inside to look like the top of a can.
3. Draw 2 vertical lines down from the left side and the right side of the oval (the widest part).
4. Connect the 2 vertical lines with an arc.
5. Draw an arc in the middle of the can. Add a circle in the middle of this arc.
6. Above the arc, draw in the "brand" of soup you are (example is "Cassidy's").
7. Below, name flavor of soup (example is "creative").
8. Add other details as needed.
9. Outline in black marker.
10. Add color to the design of the can.

Variations & Extensions:

1. Have students write about the choices they made while designing their can.
2. Have students create more than one soup to compliment aspects of their personality.
